

# The Giant Scarf Project

## Knitting guide



**1**  
You will need 50-60g chunky yarn in navy or white, and 6mm (UK 4) knitting needles.



**2**  
Cast on 42 stitches. To cast on, create a slipknot, then loop the yarn onto the needle.



**3**  
Knit in garter stitch until your panel is 21 cm wide, and 29.7 cm long. (The size of an A4!)



**4**  
Cast off all your stitches once your panel is 29.7 cm long. Don't worry about tension!

See the reverse on how to use this sheet as a size guide!



**5**  
Leave a tail and cut it to around 90 cm. The tail will be used to join your panel to the others.



**6**  
If you want to knit more than one panel, you can carry on in a new colour instead of casting off.



**7**  
Decorate your panel as you wish. Be as creative as you want! Sew on patches or buttons, embroider, anything.



**8**  
Weave in all loose ends except the 90 cm tail you have left for sewing together.



**9**  
Roll your panel up and wind the tail around the outside to secure it.



**10**  
Drop off your finished work at one of our drop-off hubs! You can find these in the starter guide.
